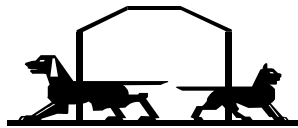


CANTERBURY KENNEL ASSN Double Banger OPEN Shows (2) SATURDAY 31 MAY 2014
